COVER ARTIST

CARLOS DÁVILA RINALDI

While other little boys wanted to be firemen and policemen, Carlos Dávila Rinaldi always dreamed of becoming an artist. His fascination with the creative forces at work in the world began while living in Japan as a child during his father's service in the Air Force. Dávila Rinaldi, who graduated with an art degree from DePauw University in 1980, is drawn to art — more specifically, to the process of creating art — as an outlet for personal expression and for its ability to distill the essence of a subject. Throughout his 40-year career, Dávila Rinaldi's work has evolved in an ongoing personal battle between abstraction and figuration. His painting Departure, which graces our cover, is a prime example of how the artist brings his surroundings — in this case, the sights and sounds of a frenzied airport scene — to life on the canvas. Dávila Rinaldi's artwork has been exhibited in Puerto Rico, throughout the U.S., and abroad.

COVER ARTIST

NICOLE EISENMAN

Born in 1965 in Verdun, France, Nicole Eisenman has defined herself as one of the most important painters of her generation by developing a powerful and timely new figurative language that combines elements both factual and fictive, mainstream and countercultural. After graduating with a BA in fine arts from the Rhode Island School of Design in 1987, Eisenman moved to Manhattan's Lower East Side where she emerged as a central figure in the resurgence of painting in America and as a singular voice for identity and culture at the margins. Eisenman's oeuvre is distinctive in its emphasis upon the allegorical and its deft mingling of autobiographical elements with historical and fictional narratives that draw attention to contemporary sociopolitical conflicts. As the artwork adorning one of our covers this issue, her painting, Sun in My Eye on the Beach, has recently been acquired by the Alfond Collection of Contemporary Art and is on view at The Alfond Inn.





GET READY TO ROCK





Performance painter extraordinaire. Accomplished studio artist. Showman of the stage. Winter Park local Rock Demarco shares what it's like to perform alongside everyone from Johnny Depp to Alice Cooper and how he's fueled every step of the way by his boundless imagination and burning need, as he says, to "paint it loud."

You've really carved out a niche in the performance painting space. How'd you come up with the idea, and who was your first subject? Twenty years ago while painting a mural in a booking agent's home, he asked if I had any art-related ideas about how to introduce a CEO's speech to a 3,000-person audience. We came up with the idea of speed painting a large image of him while guests gathered. A month later the beginning of my live art journey began and it's taken me all over the world to concerts, halflime shows, charity events, and live TV.

What's it like painting live on stage in front of thousands of people? When the curtain raises, I gaze out onto the audience — at times 200,000 people strong — and immediately absorb their energy. I'm fully in the moment and embrace that I don't have any second chances. I better be finished in time and the painting better look like my subject, which can be intimidating but also exhilarating.

What's your favorite celebrity story? I've met and performed with countless celebrities, and several have become friends. Johnny Depp was intrigued with my paintbrush finger glove that I perform with and slipped it on his hand as he sauntered around his dressing room after our concert. Johnny plays in a band with Joe Perry and Alice Cooper [another friend and fellow performer] called Hollywood

Vampires, so when I got home I sent him a glove so he could have one of his own.

Where do you find your inspiration? Whether it's the live work on stage or the studio work that hangs on my walls, my artwork captures energy. I love subjects that imply movement or mystique, and I reflect that back on the viewer. I share those moments that express the brighter side of life. Art is music to my eyes.

Is Winter Park home base? What do you enjoy most about living here? I grew up in the Northeast, so with its historic architecture and tree-lined brick streets, Winter Park really feels familiar to me. It's home. Plus, it doesn't snow. And that's a big plus.

Your children's charity is such an inspiring initiative. Tell us a little about that. Our Paint Like a ROCKstar nonprofit helps children in hospitals create, explore, and dream through art visits and paint kits. Creating art helps take them beyond their day-to-day struggles to a mental place outside of their treatment. It's truly amazing to experience the change.

We're pumped for your Rock the Avenue show in October. Can you give us a sneak peek? I'm so excited for this event! It's going to be a fun, high-energy party at the new Passport Gallery on Park Avenue featuring some of my favorite paintings of rock 'n' roll legends, Ferraris, Rolls Royces, and more. There are some surprises in store too, so everyone should come rock out!

The paintings in Dávila Rinaldi's New Works collection showcase his use of structure, composition, and balance, revealing his innovative use of shapes like ovals, rectangles, and found objects. The artist explains how he uses these basic elements in his work as markings and symbols that reflect the environments from which he creates.

From the Puerto Rico Research Hub at the University of Central Florida to Rollins College's Cornell Fine Arts Museum (CFAM)



to our very own Passport Fine Art Gallery, there is a pointed effort throughout the Central Florida community to feature the work and practices of Puerto Rican artists. Come January, Dávila Rinaldi's work will be on view at CFAM, joining the likes of acclaimed artists Antonio Martorell, Rafael Trelles, and Daniel Lind-Ramos, who reflect the varying perspectives, styles, and media of the Puerto Rican diaspora.

"Central Florida is home to a large Puerto Rican community that has grown significantly after Hurricane Maria devastated the island in 2017," says Gisela Carbonell, CFAM's curator. "The acquisition of these works is the first step in what will become a strong collection of Puerto Rican art that resonates with our community."



a magical suspension in time and space," says Brazilian artist São Yantó, a 2018 artist fellow. "Surrounded by forest, native animals, and a team of people who were always kind and helpful, I was constantly invited to create and reflect. Sometimes, when I get lost in my processes, when I lose the courage to believe in my ideas, I close my eyes and imagine myself again at ACA, given over to music and affections."






