SERVING UP SOUL

LEGENDARY CHEF NORMAN VAN AKEN IS ONCE AGAIN MAKING HIS MARK ON ORLANDO WITH HIS AFFABLE STYLE AND SIGNATURE CUISINE.



The only thing better than sitting down to dine at the new Norman's in Orlando is sitting down with the man behind the menu himself as he describes how each distinctive space opens seamlessly into the next. From the hand-cast brass bar to the chic-casual alfresco terrace to the midcentury-modern dining room, it's classic meets contemporary at Chef Norman Van Aken's newest flagship restaurant, which is poised to be a crowning achievement in a long line of successes for the "Founding Father of New World Cuisine." In between bites of sofrito-rubbed filet mignon and perfectly seared snapper, the self-taught chef shares a slice of his story in the way only he can — with humor, heart, and an unparalleled passion for his craft.

Q You had a great run with Norman's at the Ritz-Carlton Orlando, and Orlando is excited to have you back. What's it been like to open this new location?

A Yes, we were at the Ritz for 16 years. Opening a new restaurant is always another adventure — like having another child. They're all different. I've opened over 30 restaurants in my life, so you just have to be able to adapt and roll and create a new diagram if you need to. I think we've found our rhythm. It feels so great to have our doors open and welcome longtime and new guests.



Q You've been called the "Founding Father of New World Cuisine." What exactly does that mean?

A Back when I was starting out, the California food movement was really hitting an accelerated pace along with the cuisine from the Southwest. For quite some time, New Orleans had established a strong American identity as a food city. I saw an opportunity for Florida to create an identity of its own. It was around 1992, the 500th anniversary of Columbus coming to the New World, so this idea of New World Cuisine came to me. I think it does a good job of encapsulating the blend of flavors and techniques from Latin America, the Caribbean, Asia, Africa, and America.

Q What's the difference between a good restaurant and a great one?

A Soul, no question. Soul transcends knowledge. And soul isn't something you can fake. It's either real or it's not. Like great art, it reaches inside your chest and grabs you.

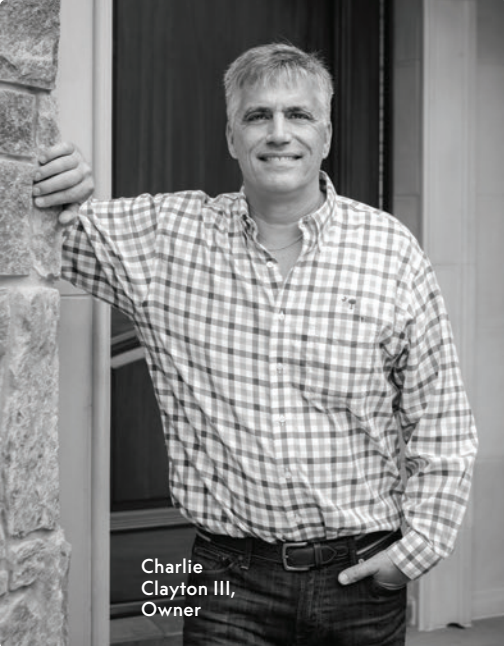


Q Speaking of art, what other comparisons do you see between art and food, or perhaps more pointedly, artists and chefs?

A I often think about the impermanence of food. Art can be made and then it continues to exist. Some people say chefs are sculptors, but we're sculptors in the rain — it doesn't last. That idea used to kind of edge me out until a friend said to me that while food may not persist in the physical sense, it lives in memory. That gave me great confidence.

Q And how do you want the food and dining experience at Norman's to live in people's memory?

A I want them to remember that it wasn't cookie-cutter. That it wasn't like anything else. That it had a true American spirit. I want them to feel like they know me and that I'm not an abstract thing, and I want them to see and feel and taste my devotion to Florida and the people who continue to come and make the state different than it was 100 years ago. 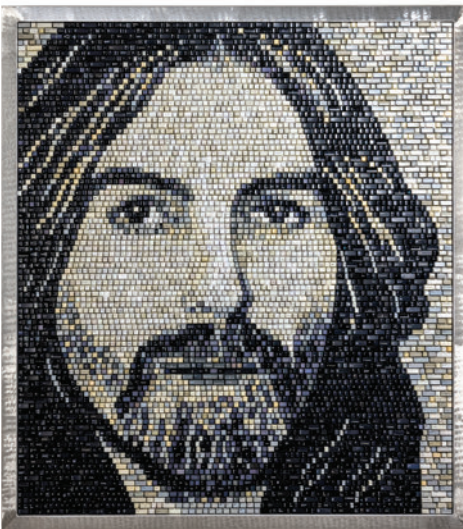

THE KEYS TO SUCCESS

PIONEERING HIS OWN ART FORM — FIRST WITH HIS SIGNATURE PORTRAITS MADE FROM REPURPOSED PUZZLE PIECES AND NOW WITH RECYCLED COMPUTER KEYS — ARTIST DOUG POWELL IS MAKING HIS MARK ON THE CONTEMPORARY ART SCENE.



For Doug Powell, a childhood fascination with string art sparked his desire to create and to explore the different outlets for his talent and passion. Powell's work, which is often referred to as contemporary pointillism, rejects the use of any digital technology. He creates each of his portraits by hand, from sketching the subject matter in pencil to gluing each meticulous detail under fixed lighting in his studio.

During the past 14 years, he has collected nearly a million upcycled computer keys that now piece together the likeness of everyone from Albert Einstein to Elon Musk. With his quadriptych of The Beatles, he has fulfilled one of his goals of creating a mosaic that exceeds 100 square feet. The project took well over 700 hours to complete and used nearly 25,000 computer keys from 250 keyboards. Hidden in the designs are approximately 40 word searches that spell out quotes from famous Beatles songs. If all the rows of keys were strung together from end to end, they would nearly reach the top of One World Trade Center in New York City.

Powell's innovative portraits have been commissioned from across the globe and most recently earned Best Booth Award at the prestigious Art Basel Miami.

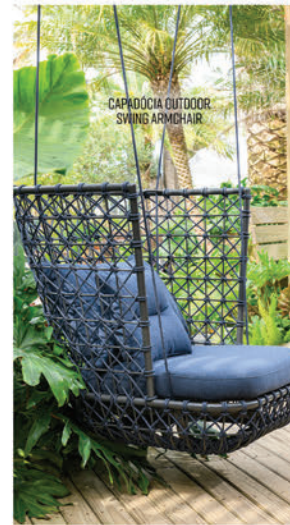

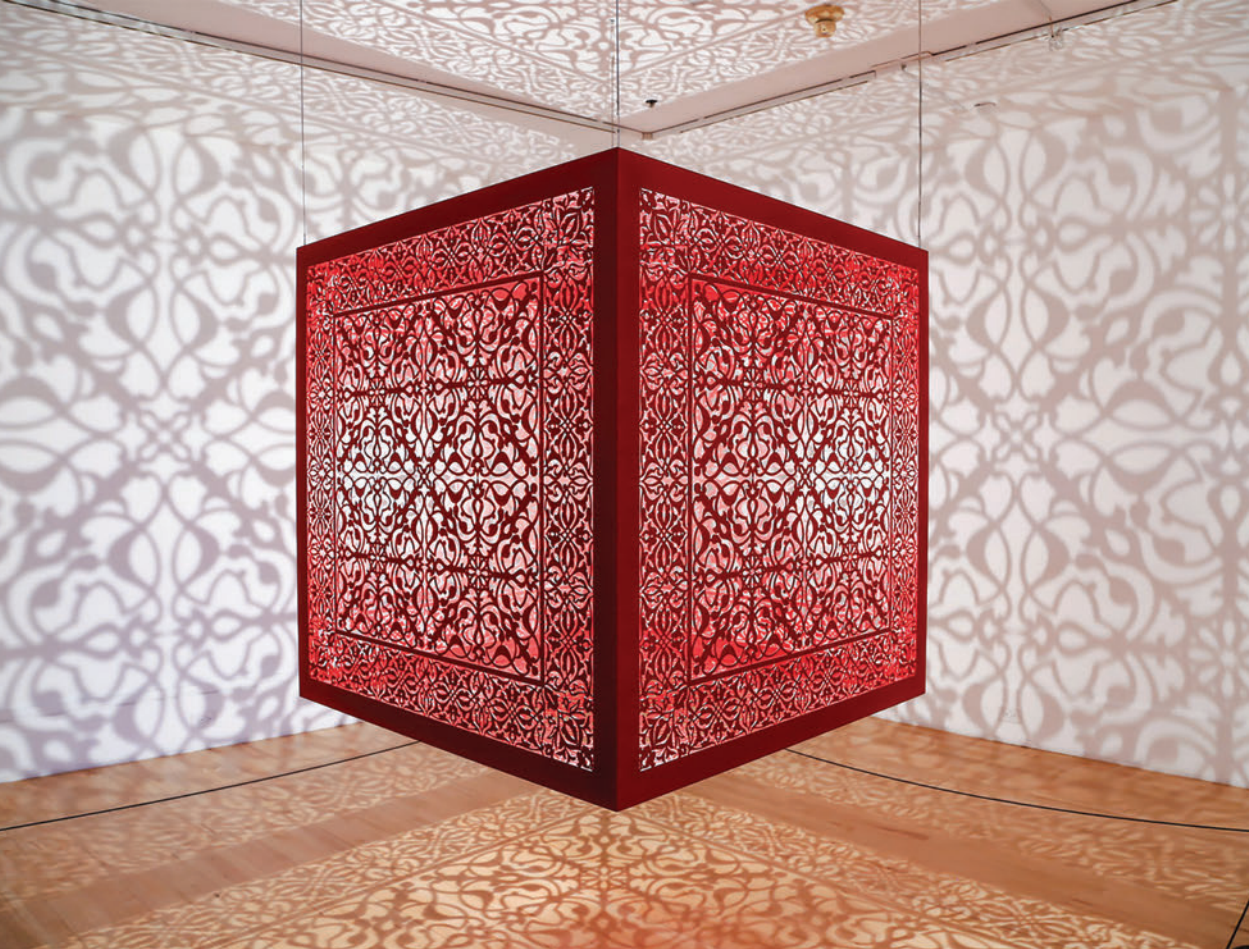
